1. When did the nominee first become involved with any kind of tambura activities, playing or promotion of tambura music in some significant way?

Jovan began playing tambura at the age of 5. He began learning from his father and grandfather. He then joined the local junior tamburitzan group at the age of 6 and learned the rest of the tamburitza instruments. At the age of 15 he began playing in a band for various ethnic functions and continued for many years following (detailed in question #5). Most recently in addition to playing, he helped plan and organize Tamburitza events to promote the Tambura and Slavic cultures. In addition to performing and promoting, Jovan is seen at many events supporting the organization and the band!

2. What was the nature of the involvement? (Musician, Teacher, Composer, Promoter, etc.)

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Jovan was a performer/musician, teacher, arranger, and promoter. As mentioned above, he played for 60 years. He taught the junior group that he was a member of, and arranged music for various junior tamburitzan groups throughout the U.S. and for bands that needed it. He was an advocate for students to diligently learn how to read music in order to be better musicians and not to learn how to "play by ear." As for promoting, Jovan hosted/helped plan tamburitza events in his city for churches, junior groups, and fundraisers. He has also served on the local committee for the Extravaganza held in Jeuno, Alaska.

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During his high school years, he began playing with the band "Local Tamburaši." They played for social events, weddings, baptisms, slavas, and receptions in the local area. After high school, he then started playing with the "Stari Brothers Tamburitza Orchestra." The band then changed members and renamed themselves to "Bez Radost Band." Later, he started his most succesful band "The Tamburitza Serenaders." Similary, they played for all types of events and traveled the country playing in cities such as Pittsburgh, Cleveland, Youngstown, Chicago area, St. Louis, Los Angeles, and Aliquippa just to name a few! He has performed at 15 Extravaganzas, 5 National Folk Festivals, and various SNF & CFU events.

Jovan demonstrated mastery level of performance specifically on Brac. However, he was capable of playing all other of the tamburitza instruments. This was demonstrated through his ability to teach each instrument and his students' success, many of whom went on to perform in bands later, perform in the Duquesne University Tamburitzans, and become Tambura teachers themselves. He encouraged his students to form small combos and perform as much as they can. He arranged songs to perform, rehearsed with them, and demonstrated professionalism for them to imitate.

During his time playing tambura, he recorded on 5 different albums (Presenting The Local Tamburasi, Kafana Night (Stari Brothers), Najlepse Pesme (Bez Radost Band), Levo i Desno (The Tamburitza Serenaders), Blizu i Daleko (The Tamuritza Serenaders) . In addition to full-length albums, he recorded individual dance sets for Junior Groups.

In 2018, he was awarded the "Dave Zupkovich Achievement Award" for his dedication and perpetuation of Tamburitza music.
